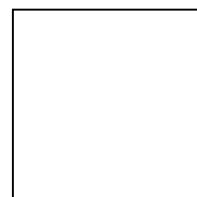

**INSTRUCTIONS, ELIGIBILITY, AND OTHER INFORMATION**

1. The program is open to teachers in any of the OH, PA, & WV counties listed on page 1 who teach science in grades K-8. You need not be designated officially as a science teacher to apply.
2. A response should be provided for each question on the form. Your responses must be typed!
3. The total cost of all items requested in a given year must not exceed \$600.
4. Do not request more than five individual items. Multiple quantities of a single item, e.g., 10 thermometers, count as one individual item.
5. Do not use more than one vendor. Please use one of the following specified vendors: (NASCO, Frey Scientific, Vernier Software and Technology or Science Kit & Boreal Laboratories) when preparing your grant application. (Websites: [www.enasco.com](http://www.enasco.com); [www.freyscientific.com](http://www.freyscientific.com); [www.vernier.com](http://www.vernier.com); [www.sciencekit.com](http://www.sciencekit.com))
6. At least 54 eligible schools submitting proposals will receive grants.
7. No single school, except under extraordinary circumstances, shall receive from this program more than one award in each two-year period, i.e., schools that received awards during the 2006/2007 school year will not be eligible for awards in 2007/2008. Schools receiving awards this school year will not be eligible in 2008/2009.
8. The items requested in a funded proposal will be purchased by the SACP and shipped directly to the teacher at his/her school address. Cash awards will not be given except in very special cases.
9. Proposal forms must be signed by the submitter and the submitter's principal or supervisor.
10. The material submitted on page 2 of the form must in no way reveal the identity of the teacher submitting the proposal or his/her school.
11. All proposals must be postmarked no later than December 5, 2007. (Extended to January 1, 2008)
12. Proposals should be sent by first class mail to: C. L. Holifield, SACP Equipment Grants, 26 Manorfield Circle, Delmont, PA 15626-1572. Mail requiring proof of delivery will not be accepted.
13. A list of winning proposals will be posted on the SACP Webpage.
