Any essay containing plagiarized material will result in rejection of the essay. Photocopies of this form may be used. Enter the number of words, exclusive of the title, in the lower left hand corner on the back of the form. The essay must be typed on the back side of this form. Or, you can tape or staple it to the back of the form. The essay page should in no way reveal the name of the writer or his/her school.
- * Student essays must be signed and submitted by a faculty member of the student's school.
- * No individual school may submit more than two essays in the middle school contest.
- * Failure to comply with these instructions may result in a scoring penalty or rejection of the essay.
