ENTRY GUIDELINES

- * The SACP Middle School Essay Contest is open to all students in grades 7 through 9 in counties listed below.

- * The maximum number of words in the essay is limited to 325. The essay is to be in prose (no poetry, please), and be the independent work of the student. Any essay containing plagiarized material will result in rejection of the essay. Enter the number of words, exclusive of the title, in the lower left hand corner of the essay page. The essay must be typed on the next page of this form. The essay page should in no way reveal the name of the writer or his/her school.
- * Student essays must be signed and submitted by a faculty member of the student's school.
- * No individual school may submit more than two essays in the middle school contest.
- * Failure to comply with these instructions may result in a scoring penalty or rejection of the essay.
